

Order of the Minister for Foreign Trade and Development Cooperation dated 6 February 2020, Min-BuZa.2020.4879-18, laying down administrative rules and a ceiling for subsidies awarded under the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Subsidy Scheme 2006 (*Subsidieregeling Ministerie van Buitenlandse Zaken 2006*) (Third round of the Subsidy Programme for the Fund against Child Labour 2018-2022)

The Minister for Foreign Trade and Development Cooperation,

having regard to Articles 6 and 7 of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Subsidy Decree (*Subsidiebesluit Ministerie van Buitenlandse Zaken*);
and Article 5.1 of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs Subsidy Scheme 2006 (*Subsidieregeling Ministerie van Buitenlandse Zaken*);

Has decided as follows:

Article 1

Applications for subsidies in the third round of the Subsidy Programme for the Fund against Child Labour 2018-2022¹ may be submitted from 24 February 2020 until 5 November 2020 15:00 CET.

Article 2

For subsidies awarded in the third round of the Subsidy Programme for the Fund against Child Labour 2018-2022, a subsidy ceiling of €5.5 million shall apply for the period from the entry into force of this Order up to and including 31 December 2020.

Article 3

This Order enters into force on the day after the publication date of the Government Gazette in which it appears and lapses with effect from 1 January 2023, on the understanding that it shall continue to apply to subsidies awarded prior to that date.

This Order and its accompanying annex will be published in the Government Gazette.
